There are three ways to return your ballot.



LA & OC County Dropboxes. Starting October 6, drop your ballots into these secure boxes.

Mail. Easily mail your ballot back with the included prepaid first class return envelope.

It **MUST** be postmarked before November 3. Earlier is better. Track your ballot at:

Vote Centers. Beginning Oct. 24 [LA] / Oct. 30 [OC], you can vote in-person, register, get a replacement ballot, and get any help you need at any center in your county.
